

GROW THE GAME Grants & Loans Post-Award Requirements

GRANTS

Grant checks will be released to the club, payable to the club, **upon receipt of picture(s) of the start of court construction and/or repairs**. (Please ensure that we have the correct name and address for the mailing.) If the scope of the project deviates from the original scope of the work proposal, the APTA reserves the right to amend the dollar amount of the grant. If the facility is sold within 18 months of receipt of the grant, the grant must be paid back in full.

LOANS

Loan checks will be released to the club, payable to the club, **upon receipt of the required signed loan documents**. (Please ensure that we have the correct name and address for the mailing.) If the scope of the project deviates from the original scope of the work proposal, the APTA reserves the right to amend the dollar amount of the loan. The loan is to be paid back on or before due dates on an annual basis until paid in full.

UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT:

- 1) The club will make its best efforts to actively promote and encourage, and when feasible, require individual APTA membership of its members. This is separate membership from the Club Membership.
- 2) The APTA will furnish a plaque that will identify the facility as an APTA Grant recipient. The facility is to secure the plaque in an easily seen location, preferably above the door to the courts.
- 3) The APTA requests pictures to be taken that can be used for press releases and publication in APTA digital media should the APTA choose to feature the facility. The APTA also requests a report on the construction of your facility; the successes and failures help us build a database for other public-access facilities and the continued growth of the game.
- 4) The Grants and Loans Committee is to be provided an annual report of court usage and program successes for the three (3) subsequent years.
